Faculty Member Serves as Resource Person for Bioinstrumentation Workshop






End Semester and Supplementary Exams

Trends in Artificial Intelligence: A Modern Perspective

The Department of Computer Science hosted an event titled "Recent Trends in Artificial Intelligence: A Modern Perspective" on July 18, 2025, at SJU Auditorium. The program began at 10:30 AM with an invocation led by Sister Elite Hongray, a 5th-semester BCA student. Miss Nangjenkala B., Assistant Professor in the Department, served as the host. The Head of the Department, Dr. T. Ebanesar, delivered the welcome address, in which he provided a concise overview of artificial intelligence and introduced the event's resource person, Mr. Akumlong Longkumer, Head of the Computer Science Department at ICFAI University Nagaland. Following these opening remarks, Mr. Longkumer commenced his presentation on the latest advancements in AI. Mr. Akumlong Longkumer began his presentation with a clear and accessible definition:

Trends in Artificial Intelligence: A Modern Perspective

Artificial Intelligence (AI) refers to systems that perceive their environment, reason about it, and take actions to achieve objectives—ranging from simple classification to complex decision-making. He emphasized that AI today spans from foundational algorithms to fully autonomous agents capable of goal-driven planning. Mr. Akumlong Longkumer delivered an in-depth PPT on generative AI, defining it as advanced AI capable of creating text, code, images, audio, and video from patterns in large datasets. The presentation underscored its transformative impact across multiple domains. He also emphasizes that the LLMs are deep learning models—typically based on Transformers—trained on massive text corpora to generate and comprehend human-like language. Examples include GPT-4 and GPT-3. They learn relationships in text via positional encoding and self-attention, allowing fluent response generation across tasks like summarization, translation, and dialogue. Modern LLMs are multimodal, supporting text, code, and vision inputs, and powering tools such as OpenAI’s ChatGPT and Meta’s Llama family. He also discussed the transformer and also neural networks. Lastly, he discussed fine-tuning, which adapts a pre-trained LLM to a specific task via additional training on labeled, task-specific data. It typically updates either all model weights or uses parameter-efficient approaches.





Faculty Development Program:

On 3rd July 2025, the Health Club, with IQAC and IIC, conducted a seminar on “Menstrual Hygiene Awareness.”


Dr. K. R. Sowmiya from Madha Medical College led the session, promoting open discussion and stressing the importance of menstrual health and wellness.
