
Faculty Activities, Academic Planning & Internship Updates :




Meeting Sub-Collector



Academic Contributions of Dr. M. Muthukrishnan

Academic Contributions of Dr. M. Muthukrishnan, Professor/Mechanical Engineering & Director/IQAC

1. Research Publication

Dr. M. Muthukrishnan has published a research paper titled “Mechanical Properties of Hybrid Epoxy Composites Reinforced with Sisal and Bamboo Fibers” in a Scopus-indexed journal on 10th June 2025. This study explores the enhancement of mechanical characteristics in hybrid composites through natural fiber reinforcement.

2. Book Chapter Publication

He has also authored a book chapter titled “Degradation of Organic Contaminants in Wastewater via Hydrodynamic Cavitation Technology”, published by Taylor & Francis on 11th June 2025. The chapter discusses innovative approaches to wastewater treatment using cavitation-based technologies.

Effect of Chemical Treatment on Mechanical Properties of Hybrid Epoxy Composites Reinforced with Sisal and Bamboo Fibers

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The research utilized hybridized composites that were hand-laid with a combination of natural reinforcing materials, an epoxy polymer matrix, and fillers made of cellulose and graphite. The reinforcing materials utilized were bamboo and sisal. Investigations on mechanical properties, thermal stability and reinforcing effects of hybrid composites were conducted by thermogravimetric and mechanical means. Mechanical testing showed that increasing the amount of bidirectionally woven bamboo fiber improved the hybrid composites' tensile and flexural strengths, whereas increasing the quantity of chopped sisal fiber reduced it. The findings of the Izod impact tests showed that chopped sisal fibers were more resistant to impact loads than braided bamboo mat fibers. Consequently, the hybrid composites' impact energy increased in direct proportion to the amount of chopped sisal fiber used. Researchers looked at the surface appearance of hybrid composites with scanning electron microscopy (SEM) and discovered multiple failure routes, such as fiber pullout and cracks.

iBlockcity: a blockchain-based smartcity architecture for secure data transmission in smartcities using the internet of everything

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Abstract: The smartcity's complex design raises several security issues for a diverse device ecosystem. A device management system is needed to control each node because an attacker is more likely to get in through a single device or node in a network of different devices. This article suggests a blockchain-based smartcity architecture for secured data transmission in smartcities using the internet of everything (IoT) called iBlockcity. The proposed architecture integrates various technologies like blockchain, IoT, machine learning, and cloud computing to create a secure and efficient system for data transmission. In addition, principal component analysis (PCA) is utilized for feature extraction and data reduction to enhance the system's performance. The proposed architecture ensures secure data transmission using blockchain technology for authentication and encryption. iBlockcity utilizes machine learning methods to optimize data processing and power usage. The suggested method is tested using a simulation environment with different datasets, and the results show that the iBlockcity effectively ensures secure data transmission in smartcities. The proposed iBlockcity architecture provides a robust and reliable solution for smartcity applications that require safe and efficient data transmission.

ABSTRACT
Advanced autonomous vehicle navigation systems enabled by AI have been utilizing high-speed real-time data from vehicle sensors for decision making process. This paper explores various deep learning approaches to improve the processing of IoT-based sensor data, focusing on three key stages: which include, preprocessing, feature selection and classification. In order to effectively reduce the noise from the raw sensor input, before the analysis is made in the next phase, some preprocessing techniques include using an outlier detection method to provide better input data in removing noise values and getting a cleaner snapshot of the sensor input data set. In the case of feature selection, we use autoencoder-based deep learning techniques that minimize and determine the relevant features for enhancing model performance. Last but not least, CNNs are used for classification since the latter demonstrates the capability of recognizing spatial patterns across the input data coming from various sensors especially in the context of obstacle detection and environment perception.


Three Drones on Campus: (05-07-2025)

Online FDP - Day 5 ; (06-07-2025)



Startup Meeting: (07-07-2025) Treading New Paths



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Abstract
 Cu doped ZnFe₂O₄ (CZFO) nanoparticles have been synthesized by sol-gel auto combustion method. The prepared samples were characterized through X-ray diffraction (XRD), Field emission scanning electron microscopy (FESEM), and Brunauer–Emmett–Teller (BET) specific surface area analysis. Crystal structure and morphology observations depicted formation Cu doped ZnFe₂O₄ (CZFO) nanoparticles with porous morphology. BET analysis reveals that the surface area was 50 m²/g for pure ZnFe₂O₄ (ZFO) as and 72 m²/g for 5%Cu doped ZnFe₂O₄ (5%CZFO) nanoparticles. Both pure and Cu doped ZnFe₂O₄ nanoparticles were tested towards xylene gas at 240 °C for 100 ppm concentration. It was found that ZFO nanoparticles can achieve response upto 23% towards xylene gas at 260 °C for 100 ppm concentration whereas insertion Cu into ZnFe₂O₄ increased the response upto 44.3% at 240 °C for 100 ppm concentration. In addition, CZFO nanoparticles showed quick response/ recovery rate 56/128 s respectively and high stability. The selectivity towards various gases such as ethanol, ammonia, triethylamine, xylene and acetone.






