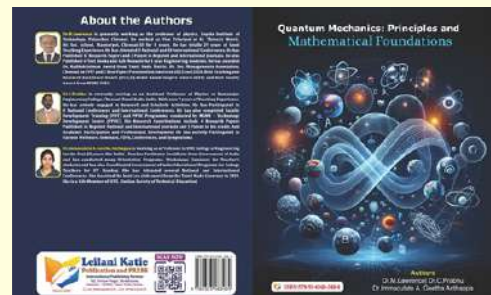

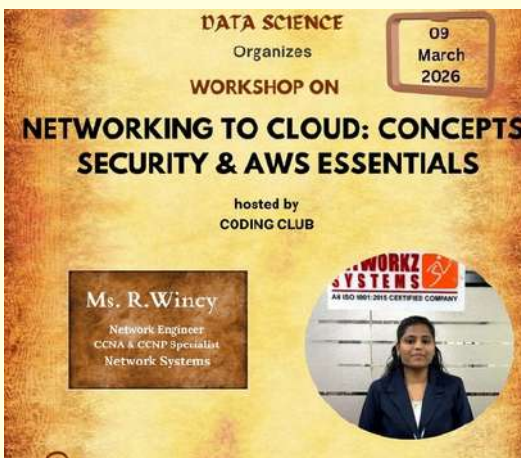


CAMPUS RECRUITMENT BY MAFIREE

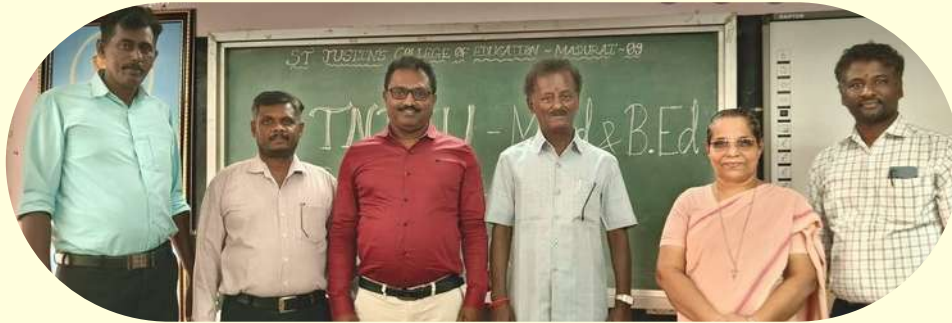
**INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE ON TECHNOLOGY
