





Post-traumatic acute Marjolin ulcer with a short latency period in a young man: a case report

Abstract
Background Marjolin ulcer was first mentioned by Celsius in the first century as a malignant transformation of burn scars, which can be caused by chronic wounds. Marjolin ulcer has been observed to have a latent period of over 10 years and occasionally even 36 years, with a small number of reports of short latent periods. Squamous-cell carcinoma (SCC) is the most common histology and is often characterized by an ulcerated wound around the injury site with raised margins. Marjolin ulcer squamous-cell carcinoma's poor vascularity makes it difficult for it to respond to chemotherapy and radiotherapy. There is lack of data on acute Marjolin ulcer related to post-traumatic wounds in sub-Saharan Africa. We are reporting on a rare case of acute Marjolin ulcer squamous-cell carcinoma of the lower limb that was treated at Ocean Road Cancer Institute in Tanzania. The authors sought to enhance awareness of acute Marjolin ulcer in low- and middle-income countries.
Case description This is a case of a 35-year-old male patient of African origin who was working as an agriculture officer and was involved in a motor bicycle traffic accident 6 years prior at the age of 29 years and sustained facial, chest, and right lower limb injuries, which healed by secondary intention 3 months later. A total of 6 months later, he was diagnosed with invasive squamous-cell carcinoma around the lesions in his right knee. The patient was treated with surgery, chemotherapy, and radiotherapy.
Conclusion To our knowledge, this is likely to be the first reported case of acute Marjolin ulcer in East Africa and the third in Africa. This highlights the challenges in diagnosing and managing acute Marjolin ulcer in low- and middle-income countries. The short latent period of acute Marjolin ulcer in Africa necessitates genetic and immunological studies. Where possible, deep chronic wounds should be grafted, while unstable scars should be excised and grafted.

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Chemoprevention by Berries: A Comprehensive Literature Review

Abstract
 Cancer remains a leading cause of morbidity and mortality worldwide, prompting growing interest in dietary chemoprevention as a complementary approach to conventional therapies. Among dietary factors, berries represent a rich source of bioactive phytochemicals with demonstrated antioxidant, anti-inflammatory, and anticancer activities. This review provides a comprehensive synthesis of current evidence on the chemopreventive potential of berries, focusing on their diverse phytochemicals such as anthocyanins, flavonols, stilbenes, proanthocyanidins, phenolic acids, tannins, and vitamin C. Special emphasis is placed on ellagitannins and ellagic acid, key compounds extensively investigated in experimental and translational research. Preclinical and clinical findings are critically appraised, highlighting underlying molecular mechanisms and challenges in bioavailability and translation to clinical practice. Collectively, the evidence supports berries as promising candidates for dietary chemoprevention, while underscoring the need for standardized clinical trials and improved formulations for enhanced efficacy.

Resolution of Pseudoainhum with Acitretin in Lamellar Ichthyosis

Abstract

Lamellar ichthyosis is an autosomal recessive type of ichthyosis characterized by abnormal skin scaling, ectropion and ear abnormalities. Pseudoainhum is the appearance of constriction bands around digits which can lead to autoamputation of digits. Here we report a case of Lamellar ichthyosis with Pseudoainhum, which showed reversal of Pseudoainhum with 6 months of acitretin therapy.

Key-words: Pseudoainhum, congenital ichthyosis, acitretin

Introduction

Lamellar ichthyosis is an autosomal recessive type of ichthyosis which often presents as a collodion baby at birth and later manifests as ichthyosis with large polydonal, dark adherent scaling. Other clinical features include ectropion, onychodysplasia, palmoplantar keratoderma, ocatricial alopecia and ear abnormalities. Pseudoainhum is the term used for appearance of annular constriction bands around digits. Pseudoainhum occurs in various conditions like palmoplantar keratoderma, trauma, systemic sclerosis, chronic plaque psoriasis, pachyonychia congenita, erythropoietic protoporphyria, and Olmsted's syndrome. Autoamputation of digits is a dreaded complication of pseudoainhum. Pseudoainhum is generally managed surgically; here we have a case of lamellar ichthyosis with pseudoainhum which resolved with acitretin therapy.

Case Report

A 29 - year- old female came with complaints of scaling all over the body with extensor predilection since birth which was exacerbated during winter. She was a single full-term baby, born of a consanguineous marriage (second degree), by normal vaginal delivery. History suggestive of collodion membrane was present at birth. There was a history of developing large brown scaling all over the body predominantly on the extensor aspect of limbs since childhood along with watering and difficulty in closure of eyes. There was no history

suggestive of erythroderma, blisters, hearing/visual abnormality or any other systemic complaints.

On examination, she had generalized ichthyosis, with large dark brown scales seen all over the face, trunk and extensor aspect of extremities. Ectropion and scaling were seen in face with no gross abnormality of the ears (Figure-1 A, B, C).

Distal onycholysis and longitudinal ridging were seen in toe nails. Constriction band (Pseudoainhum) was seen in left little finger (Figure- 1D). Ophthalmology and ENT evaluation were normal. All routine investigations like complete blood count, renal profile, liver profile, lipid profile were within normal limits. Skin biopsy showed hyperkeratosis, parakeratosis and focal spongiosis (Figure 2).

Based on history, examination and investigation, she was diagnosed as a case of congenital autosomal recessive lamellar ichthyosis and was treated with keratolytics, moisturizers and antihistamines. She was started on acitretin 25 mg OD after routine investigation and ensuring negative pregnancy test. As she was not willing for surgical management of pseudoainhum, she was followed up for 6 months. After 6 months, she showed near complete resolution of pseudoainhum while she was on acitretin. 
LL.M. Classes and Teaching Practice

Friendly Game



Faculty Development Programme on Patent and Innovation


